RESOLUTION NO. 151-93

OPPOSING THE TRANSFER OF THE CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE OF M/V DIAMOND I (FORMERLY M/V TOKISHIRO) TO ANY THIRD ENTITY OWNED AND CONTROLLED BY MR. DOMINGO REYES, OTHER THAN VIVA SHIPPING LINES, INC. AND STO. DOMINGO LINES, INC., TO PREVENT THE EXISTENCE OF A SHIPPING MONOPOLY IN THE CALAPAN-DATANGAS SEA ROUTE.

WHEREAS, the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) has announced that it will sell by public auction the vessel M/V Diamond I (formerly M/V Tokishiro) owned and operated by the Manila International Shipping Corporation, Ltd. (MISCL);

WHEREAS, a Certificate of Public Convenience has been issued by the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) to M/V Diamond I to engage in the carriage of passengers and goods in the Calapan-Datangas sea route;

WHEREAS, the other shipping companies operating in the Calapan-Datangas sea route, namely Viva Shipping Lines (VSL) and Sto. Domingo Lines (SOL), are both owned and controlled by Mr. Domingo Reyes;

WHEREAS, Section 10, Article XII, of the 1967 Constitution provides that "(t)he State shall regulate or prohibit monopolies when the public interest so requires";

WHEREAS, there will practically be a monopoly by Mr. Domingo Reyes and his shipping companies of the Calapan-Datangas sea route if the Certificate of Public Convenience of M/V Diamond I, their lone competitor, is transferred to a third entity (other than VSL and SOL) owned and controlled by Mr. Domingo Reyes;

WHEREAS, a monopoly by Mr. Domingo Reyes and his shipping companies of the Calapan-Batangas sea route could be prejudicial to the interest of the people of Oriental Mindoro;

WHEREAS, there should be constructive competition in the Calapan-Batangas sea route to promote efficiency in the management and operation of vessels consistent with the interest, necessity and convenience of the travelling public;


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, as it is hereby received, to vigorously oppose the transfer of the Certificate of Public Convenience of M/V Diamond I (formerly M/V Tokichino) to engage in the carriage of passengers and goods in the Calapan-Batangas sea route to any third entity owned and controlled by Mr. Domingo Reyes, other than VCL and SCL, to prevent a shipping monopoly prejudicial to the interest of the people of Oriental Mindoro.

Let copies of this resolution be furnished the Office of the President, the Secretary of Communications and Transportation, the MARINA Administrator, the MARINA Board, and the NBP.




