RESOLUTION NO. 201-93

A RESOLUTION VIGOROUSLY OPPOSING ANY APPLICATION FILED BY VIVA SHIPPING LINES AND STO. DOMINGO SHIPPING LINES WITH THE MARITIME INDUSTRY AUTHORITY (MARINA) FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) ADDITIONAL VESSELS OF 200 TON CAPACITY TO BE FIELDDED IN THE CALAPAN-BATANGAS/BATANGAS-CALAPAN SEA ROUTE.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan has acquired a reliable information that the Viva Shipping Lines and Sto. Domingo Shipping Lines filed an application with MARINA for the purchase of two (2) vessels of 200 ton capacity to be fieldded in the Calapan-Batangas/Batangas-Calapan Sea Route;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan has arrived at a consensus to express vigorous opposition to such application if in fact the same has already been filed because the ton capacity of the two (2) vessels Viva Shipping Lines and Sto. Domingo Shipping Lines are contemplating to purchase shall not comply with existing rules and regulations of MARINA regarding tonnage requirement on vessels plying the aforementioned route.

WHEREAS, considering the normal volume of passengers and the cargoes that are being shipped regularly, the ton capacity of the vessels to be acquired will not be able to fully respond to the convenience and safety of the riding public.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved that the Sangguniang Panlalawigan vigorously opposes any application filed by Viva Shipping Lines and Sto. Domingo Shipping Lines with the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) for the purchase of two (2) additional vessels of 200 ton capacity to be fieldded in the Calapan-Batangas/Batangas-Calapan Sea Route.

RESOLVED, that the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA) thru Hon. Paciencia Balbon, Administrator, Marina be furnished copies of this

resolution, for his information and appropriate action.

On motion of Hon. Jose A. Enriquez, Sr., duly seconded by All Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan present, said resolution was UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.
