RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN'S WHOLEHEARTED GREETINGS TO HONORABLE ARNAN CAPULONG PANALIGAN, GOVERNOR, PROVINCE OF ORIENTAL MINDORO ON THE OCCASION OF HIS 48TH BIRTHDAY ON THE 21ST DAY OF JANUARY 2010

WHEREAS, Hon. Arnan C. Panaligan was born on January 21, 1962 at Calapan City by his parents Mr. Leandro Panaligan and Mrs. Araceli Panaligan;

WHEREAS, a lawyer by profession, Governor Arnan C. Panaligan finished law at the Ateneo Law School in 1987 and passed the Bar Examination that same year; his previous experiences include a stint in the Supreme Court as legal researcher after passing the Bar and in the House of representatives Electoral Tribunal as technical assistant;

WHEREAS, Governor Arnan C. Panaligan entered politics in 1995 as Municipal Mayor of Calapan, Oriental Mindoro where he served for three consecutive terms; in 2004, he was elected Vice-Governor of Oriental Mindoro and assumed the Office of the Governor on 01 December 2004 upon the death of the late Governor Bartolome L. Marasigan;

WHEREAS, hailed as the architect of progress in Calapan City, Governor Arnan C. Panaligan was responsible for transforming the sleepy town into a booming and progressive city;

WHEREAS, it was under his administration as Mayor of Calapan that marked the building of concrete roads and drainage network, opened schools in rural areas, provided health insurance to poor families, and provided scholarships to thousands of young people;

WHEREAS, his tenure as Mayor also marked the entry of investments that contributed to the progress of the whole province;



WHEREAS, as a sign of respect to the father of our beloved province, it is but proper that he be given due acknowledgment on the very special day of his life;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved to extend warmest greetings to Honorable Arnan C. Panaligan, Governor, Province of Oriental Mindoro on the occasion of his 48th birthday on the 21st day of January 2010;
