

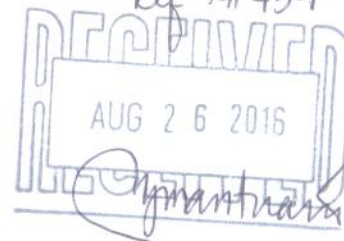



SUBJECT : REVIEW OF MEMORANDA OF AGREEMENT INVOLVING THE PGO_rM AND TWENTY TWO (22) TRI-MEDIA ENTITIES

Referred to this Office for evaluation are Twenty Two (22) Memoranda of Agreement (MOA) between the Provincial Government of Oriental Mindoro (PGO_rM) and various tri-media entities covering the period July to December 2016, which pertain to all regular broadcasting and publishing of news reports of the PGO_rM's programs, projects, special events, and important undertakings related to its developmental thrust. The involved tri-media entities are listed below with their corresponding contract amount per month, *viz.*

It may be borne out by the records that twenty one (21) Memoranda of Agreement with the same purpose as the presently submitted legal instruments had been previously reviewed by this Office under PLO-AR NO. 3-04, Series of 2016 dated 27 January 2016. The effectivity period of the previously-reviewed MOA is January to June 2016. As such, those Agreements have already expired.

This time, before us are the same Tri-Media Agreements which seek for the renewal of the earlier-executed Agreements. Aside from the addition of one tri-media entity, the presently submitted Agreements contain almost the same terms and provisions as the previous Agreements.

Meanwhile, it is noted that in the present set of documents, PGOOrM intends to enter into two (2) individual Agreements with the J.L.P. Broadcasting Agency (Radyo Natin Pinamalayan) for two different purposes—one for the broadcasting of KPSM and the other is for the broadcasting of PIO Infomercials. It may be considered that only one Agreement be executed with the broadcasting company, ensuring, of course, that the terms of engagement with such company are clear outright.

Finally, after review of the specific terms and provisions of the submitted twenty two (22) MOA, it was found that they are in accord with the law, public order and public policy. Hence, their execution is **RECOMMENDED**.
